CBAM Recap



What is CBAM meant for? Preventing Carbon Leakage from the EU.



What is the scope of CBAM? Currently - Cement, Fertilisers, Iron & Steel, Aluminium, Hydrogen and electricity.



When does it apply? It will be applied in phases. Transition period has already started.



What is expected? Carbon emissions data with high level of granularity. Reports to be made quarterly.



Who is liable for reporting? Importers bear the reporting burden.

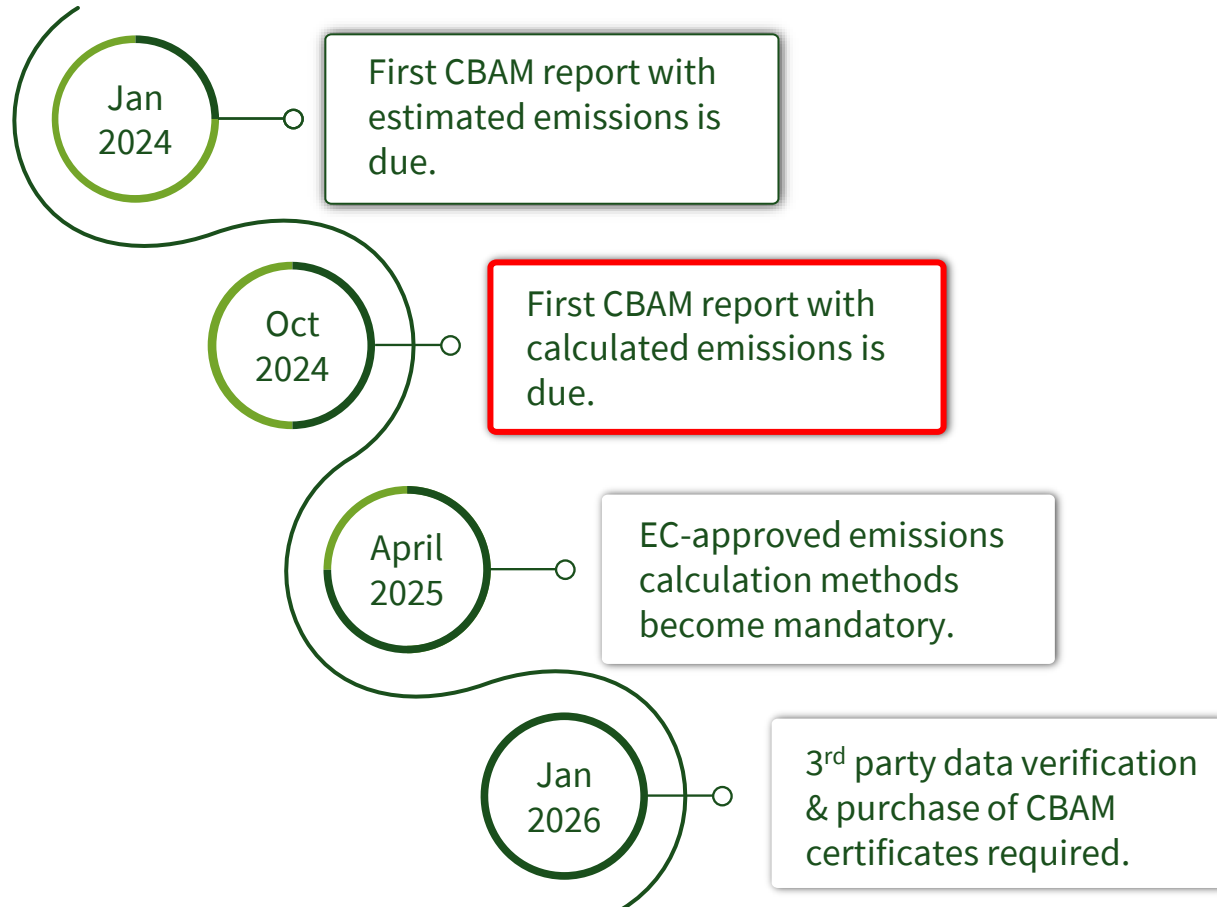


Who is responsible for data? Producers/Manufacturers need to provide accurately measured emissions.



Who can support you? If you are a non-resident company, Simarco can support you in CBAM's complicated process and make declarations on your behalf.

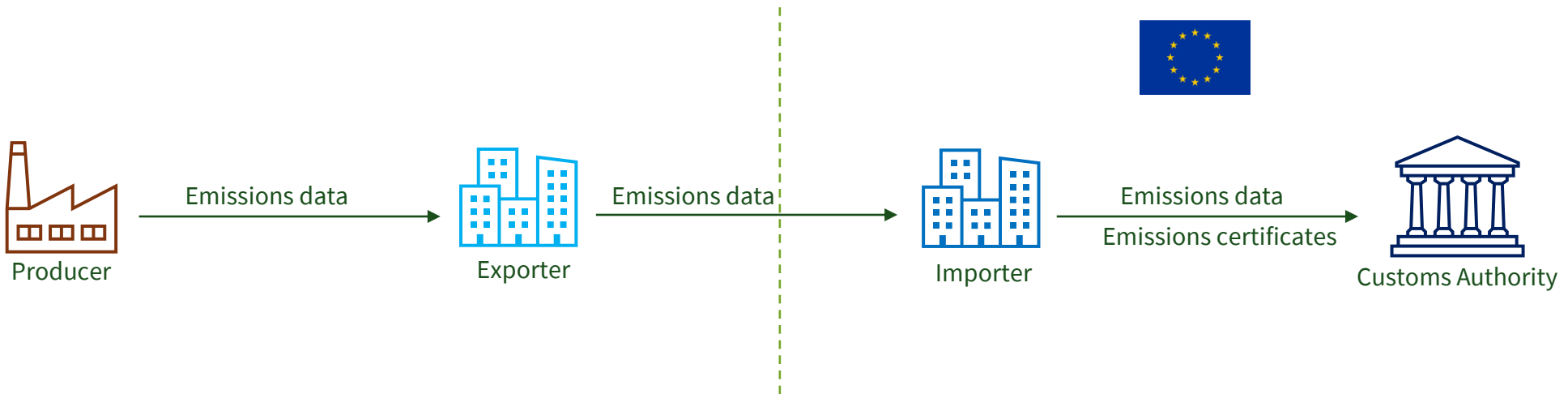
Timeline for implementation – CBAM



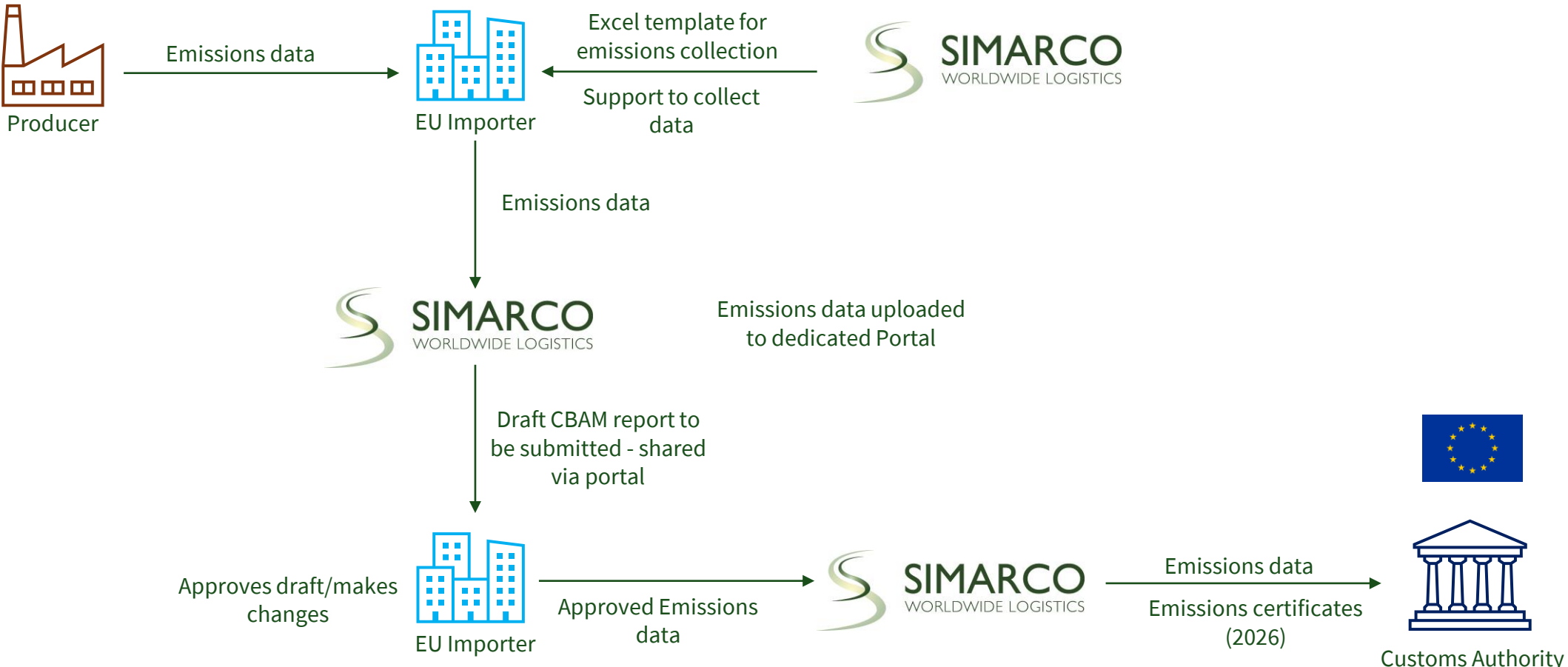
Phase-in of required certificates
